ELECTION/ANNOUNCEMENT OF OFFICERS

James Shalleck was elected to serve as the Chairperson of the Board of Canvassers. Mary Ann Keeffe was elected to serve as the Secretary for the Board of Canvassers. The motion passed unanimously.

PUBLIC NOTICE OF CANVASS

Public notice of the first absentee canvass was provided by a media release on October 29, 2018, it was posted on the Montgomery County Board of Elections' website and was mailed to candidates.

VERIFICATION OF BALLOT SCANNERS

Margaret Jurgensen, Election Director, presented documents to the Board of Canvassers showing that the ballot scanners being used in the canvass successfully passed Logic and Accuracy Testing. Margaret Jurgensen reported that the memory cards created for this canvass were placed in the ballot scanners and sealed. Margaret Jurgensen provided the Board of Canvassers with the results from the Logic and Accuracy Testing. CANVASSING

Overview of Canvass Process

James Shalleck, President of the Board of Elections and Chair of the Board of Canvassers provided an introduction to the canvass teams. Margaret Jurgensen, Election Director, explained the rules concerning public observation of the canvass, provided an overview of the canvassing process, and noted that the rules were posted in the canvass room.

Margaret Jurgensen, Election Director, explained that each provisional ballot application was reviewed prior to canvassing to determine the voter's eligibility to vote in this election and the voter's correct ballot style. At this canvass, the provisional ballot applications were presented to the Board of Canvassers with a recommendation. The recommendations were:

- 1. Accept provisional ballot application in full recommend counting all votes cast on the provisional ballot.
- Accept provisional ballot application in part recommend counting some but not all
 votes cast on the provisional ballot style other than from the voter's jurisdiction,
 containing jurisdiction specific candidates, not available to out-of-jurisdiction voters,
 and statewide candidates, available to all voters.
- 3. Reject provisional ballot application recommend not counting the provisional ballot for one of the reasons below.

Canvassing the Provisional Ballots

10,502 Provisional Ballots were presented for canvassing at this canvass.

Results

- 1. Election Director/staff presented 7,391 provisional ballots with the recommendation to accept them in full. The recommendation was based on the fact that staff had confirmed that each provisional application was submitted by a registered voter and was cast in the correct precinct where that voter currently resides. The Board unanimously voted to accept the recommendation and accept and count the provisional ballots in full.
- 2. Election Director/staff presented 2,061 provisional ballots with the recommendation to accept them in part. The recommendation was based on the fact that staff had confirmed that each provisional application was submitted by a registered voter and the provisional ballot was cast in the wrong precinct. The Board unanimously voted to accept the recommendation, and the ballots were referred to the duplicating team.
- 3. Election Director/staff presented 893 provisional ballots with the recommendation to reject because staff could not confirm that the applicant was a registered voter. The Board unanimously voted to accept the recommendation and reject the ballots.
- 4. Election Director/staff presented 55 provisional ballots with the recommendation to reject because the applicant returned a voted absentee ballot or already voted. The Board unanimously voted to accept the recommendation and reject the ballots.
- 5. Election Director/staff presented 25 provisional ballots with the recommendation to reject because the voter failed to sign the provisional ballot application. The Board unanimously voted to accept the recommendation and reject the ballots.
- 6. Election Director/staff presented 2 provisional ballots with the recommendation to reject because the applicant was not eligible to receive a provisional ballot. The Board unanimously voted to accept the recommendation and reject the ballots.
- 7. Election Director/staff presented 15 provisional ballots with the recommendation to reject because the applicant did not provide identification or personal identification information in time. The Board unanimously voted to accept the recommendation and reject the ballots.
- 8. Election Director/staff presented 5 provisional ballots with the recommendation to reject because the applicant provided incomplete information on the provisional ballot application. The Board unanimously voted to accept the recommendation and reject the ballots.
- 9. Election Director/staff presented 31 provisional ballots with the recommendation to reject because the applicant provided his or her driver's license or social security number, but the number was not verified. The Board unanimously voted to accept the recommendation and reject the ballots.
- 10. Election Director/staff presented 15 provisional ballots with the recommendation to reject because the applicant will not be or is not 18 years old or older by the general election. The Board unanimously voted to accept the recommendation and reject the ballots.

11. Election Director/staff presented 9 provisional ballots with the recommendation to reject because the applicant did not provide proof of residency in time. The Board unanimously voted to accept the recommendation and reject the ballots.
