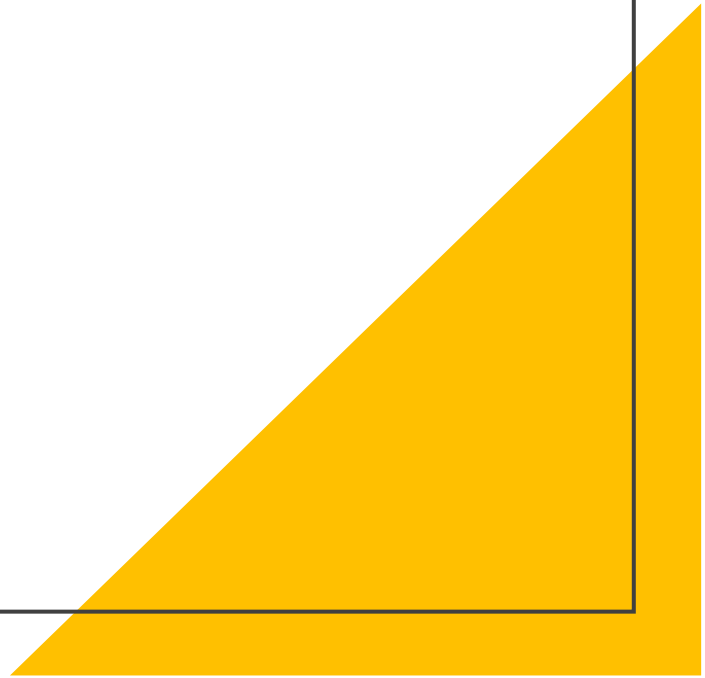

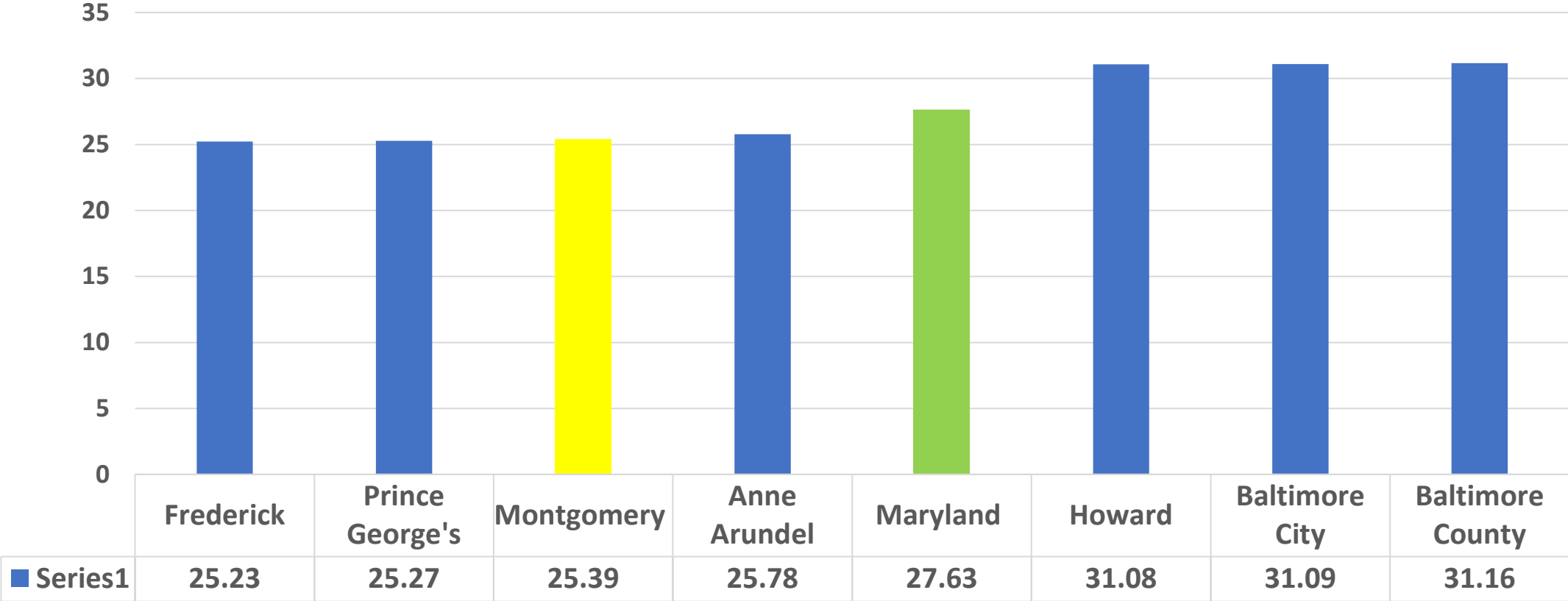

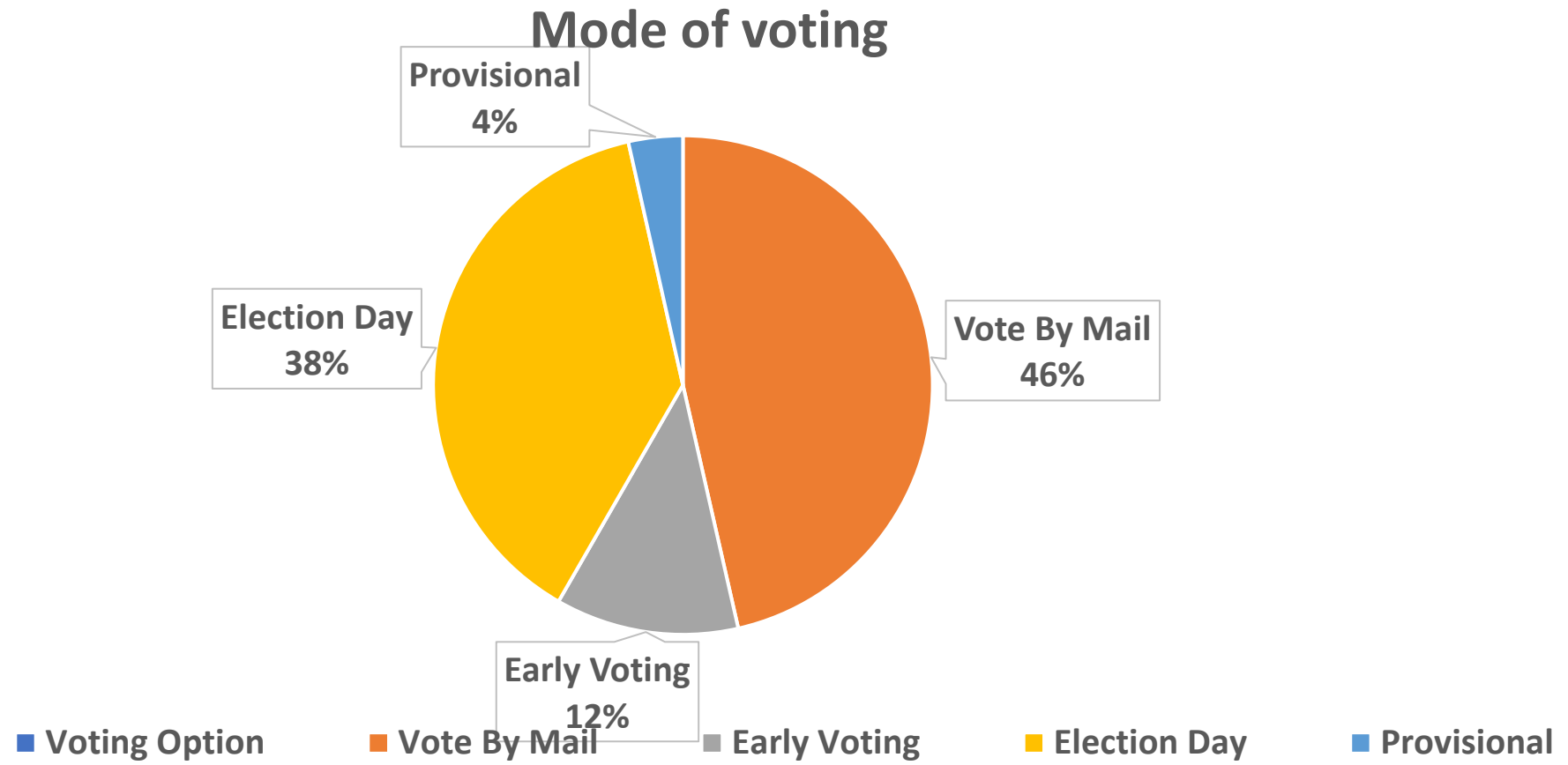

Mail In Ballots – Return Rate

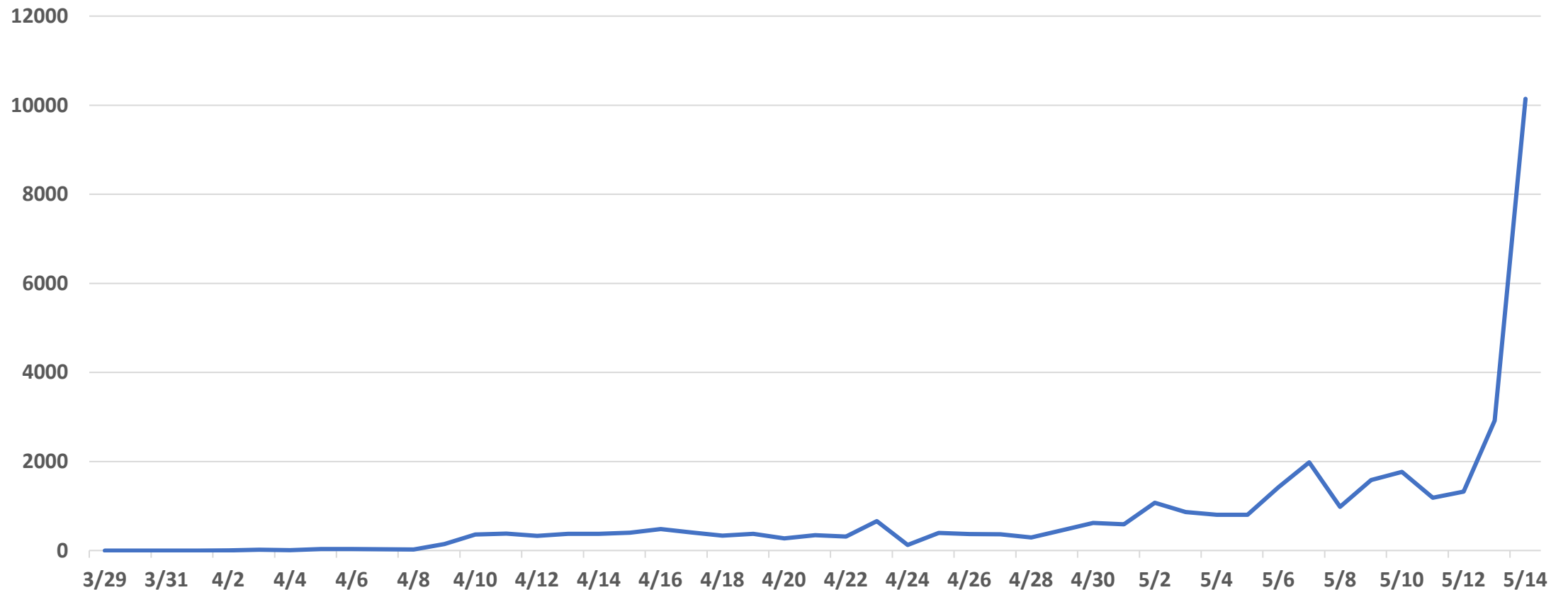
- The 2024 Presidential Primary Mail-In Ballot return rate was 60%
 - The 2024 Presidential Primary MIB return rate in MD – 66.6%

 - The 2022 Gubernatorial Primary Mail-In Ballot return rate was 63.9%
 - The 2022 Gubernatorial Primary MIB return rate in MD was 67.3%

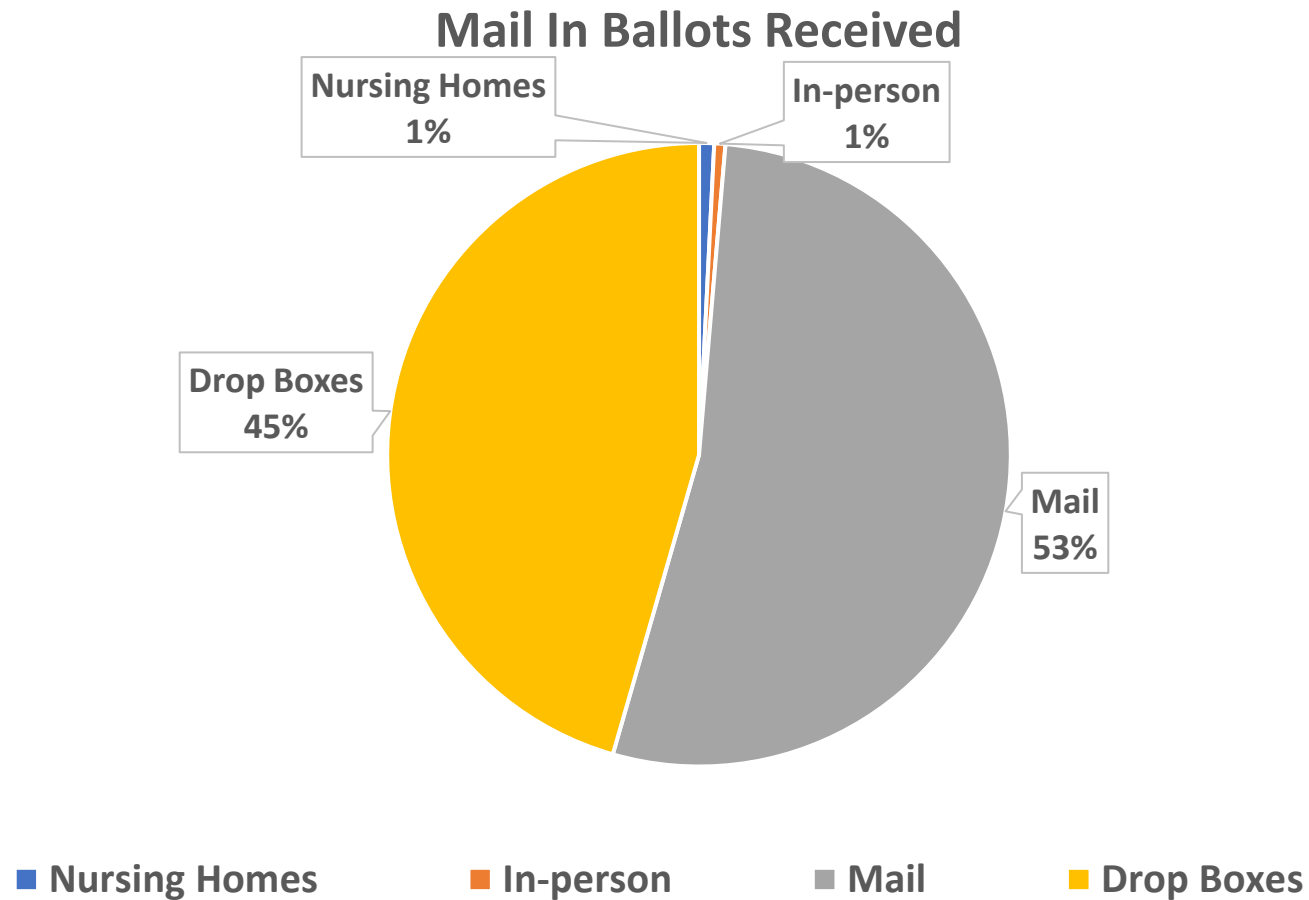
 - The 2022 Gubernatorial General Mail-In Ballot return rate was 83.5%

Unequal participation across the county

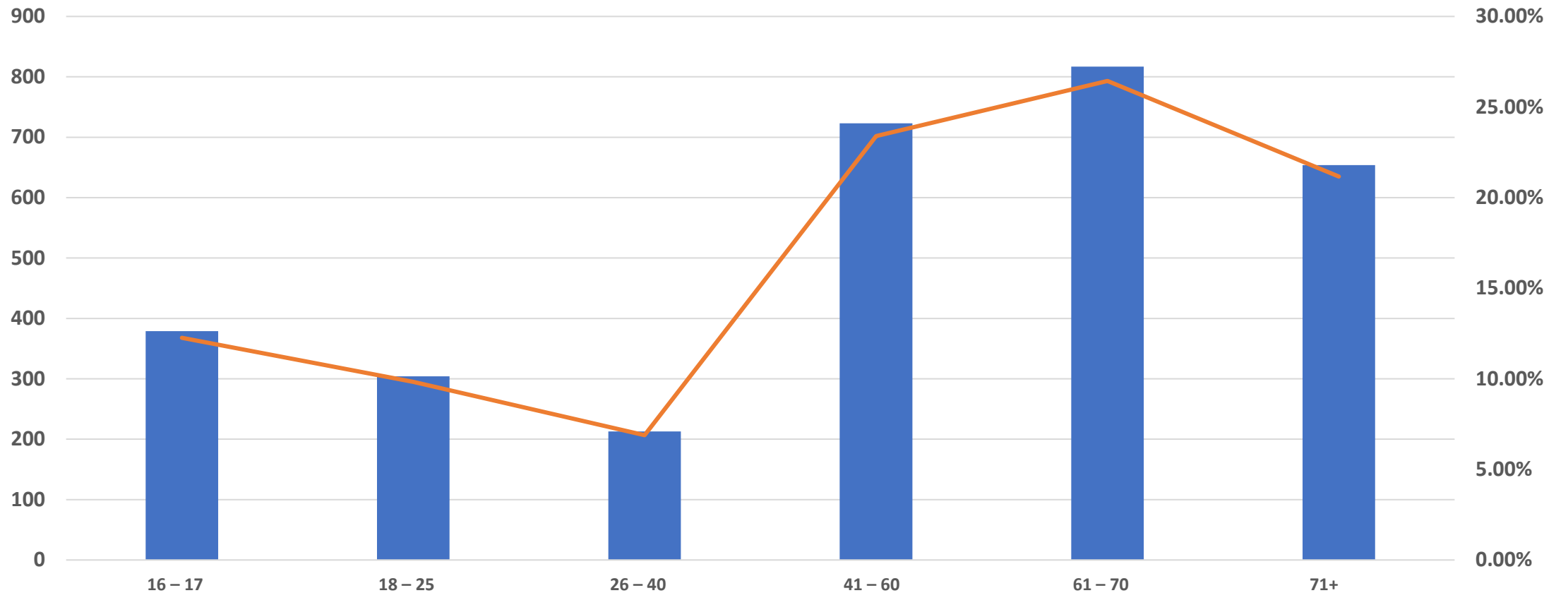
Unequal participation across party affiliations

Hard to recruit: Chiefs and Same Day Registration

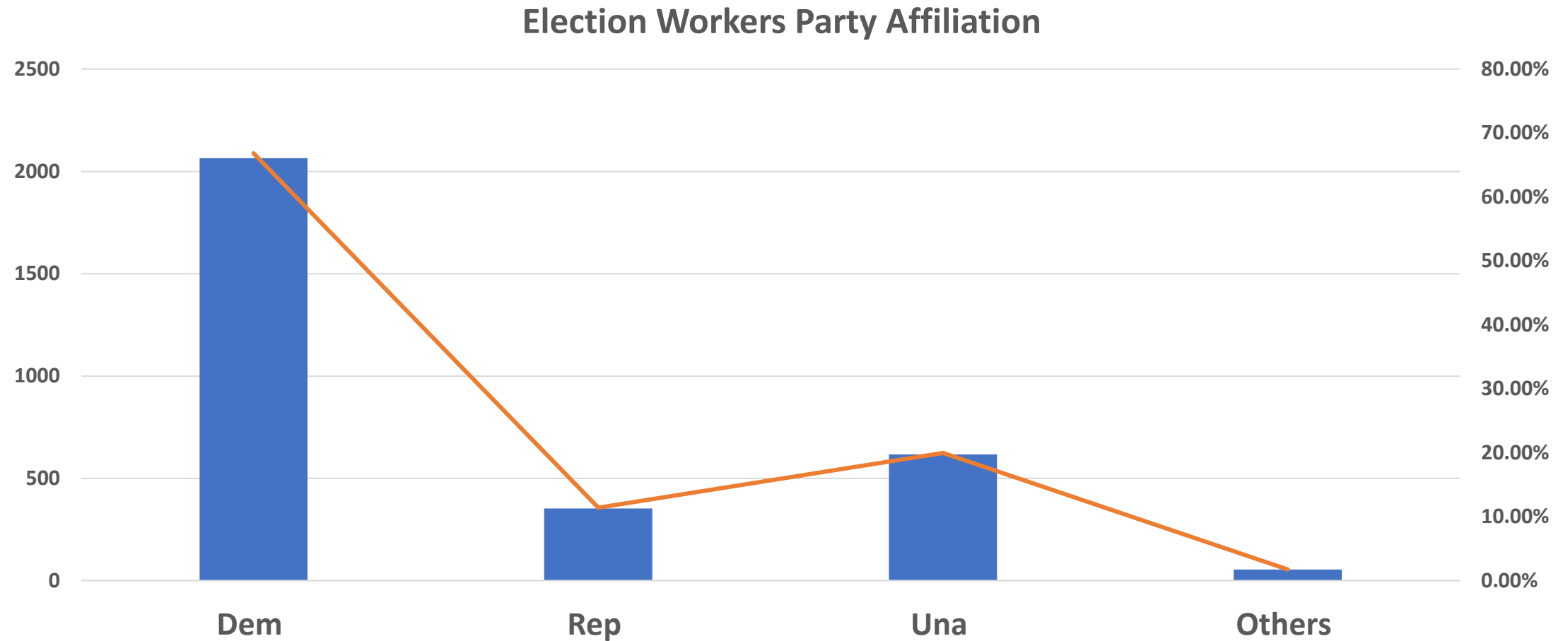
High number of younger Election Workers

Comparison to the 2022 Primary Election data:

Total number of Provisionals: -22%

Requested MIB but voted Provisional: -24%

Voted the wrong party ballot: -50%

Voted in wrong precinct: -3%
