December 2021 – Election Worker Information for 2022
June 16 – June 23, 2022 – Primary Early Voting
June 28, 2022 – Gubernatorial Primary Election
October 27 – November 3, 2022 – General Early Voting
November 8, 2022 – Gubernatorial General Election

In the Making . . .

- Absentee Ballots will now be referred to as Mail-In Ballots
- Permanent Mail-In ballot status will become available soon (TBD)
- Redistricting based on the 2020 Census is a possibility
- Training will *continue* to include: Quiz, Training Module, In-Person Class
- BOE Training Rooms 1, 2 and 3 will be become primarily dedicated to ballot processing, most training classes will be offsite
- New electronic pollbook printers (EPB's) are being considered
- Montgomery County will be adding more Early Voting Centers for 2022
- The BOE will return to using most of the previous 230+ polling precincts
