What's Next? The recruitment team is working on payroll for the Election Workers. Those who selected to receive the service stipend for their volunteer service, will receive their stipend checks six weeks after Election Day. The service stipend checks will be mailed to your address of record. The students who chose to receive SSL hours in lieu of the stipend can expect the SSL forms to be mailed by September 2, 2022. The SSL coordinator will forward the SSL form directly to you via email.



We will begin staffing for the Gubernatorial General Election in early September. We communicate heavily via email, so please keep an eye out.
