New for the 2024 Election Cycle New Election Worker pay rates for the service stipend will begin with the 2024 Election Cycle. Most full-day positions for example, Voter Operations worker (VOP), Provisional worker (VOP-P) or Same-Day Registration worker (SDR) can earn \$250 for their service and \$50 for their training. Additionally, returning Election Workers who previously served at a polling place during early voting or Election Day will earn \$100 extra each full day of service during early voting and/or election day in the 2024 election cycle. We celebrated National Voter Registration Day on Tuesday, September 19, 2023. This day is recognized as a nonpartisan civic holiday celebrating our democracy. It is designed to ensure every eligible voter can vote. National Voter Registration Day involves volunteers and organizations all over the country conducting outreach to register voters. The Montgomery County Board of Elections visited local libraries to register individuals to vote and recruit election workers and promoted voter registration on social media platforms – X and Facebook.

Community Outreach Drive The recruitment and outreach teams will be visiting local community events to inform and recruit new participants for the Election Worker Program.

For the calendar year, outreach efforts of the Montgomery County Board of Elections have included the promotion of voter registration and recruitment of election workers at over 160 events. These events were either organized by our Outreach Team or we were invited to present our efforts.
