### Election Worker Stipend Rates Change

Effective July 3, 2017, the stipend rates for election workers changed. The service pay portion of the stipend increased between \$30 and \$50, based on position. The training pay stipend did not change.

Election Workers receive a set payment, based on their assigned position, for successfully completing all required training and working on Election Day. *Workers who complete training but do not serve will not be paid.*

#### New service rates:

Chief Judges - \$250 + \$50 for training = \$300

Closing Judges - \$100 + \$30 for training = \$130

Voting Operation Judges - \$180 + \$30 for training = \$210

Part time VOP Judges - \$90/shift + \$30 for training = \$120

#### **2018 Polling Place Changes**

Some polling place changes have been proposed for 2018 for a variety of reasons, such as construction. Changes will be finalized in January. Additional information is available on our website.

#### **Voter Registrar Training**

Do you want to help register people to vote? Voter registration distributors are trained to assist people with registering to vote and delivering completed applications to a county board of elections.

To be a voter registration distributor, you must be 18 years of age or older. You will receive training on how to complete Maryland's voter registration application and ensure that the application is completed and accurate and information about the State's identification requirements. After the training, you must sign an affidavit that you will act according to the training and regulations and will receive a certificate identifying you as a voter registration volunteer. You may not receive compensation on a per registrant basis for voter registration activity.

Classes are held at the Montgomery Board of Elections weekly on a walk-in basis on Wednesdays at 10:00 AM and 3:00 PM. Registration is not required. Our office is located at 18753 N. Frederick Avenue, Suite #210, Gaithersburg, MD 20879.

Evening classes may be arranged with 10 days' notification if you have ten or more people attending. Please call Laletta Dorsey on 240-777-8509 to make group arrangements.
