



- B. The Board reviewed and voted on 4 cases as file reviews. This type of review requires the guardianship clients to be stable medically and, in their living, arrangements for at least a year. The client's social worker and attorney are not required to be present unless a full review is requested by the Board, the client, the social worker, or the court appointed attorney.
