


# Total Literally Homeless: 10 Year Review






### **Annual Point-in-Time Count** (Individuals)




### **Annual Point-in-Time Count (Families)**



### Percent Change Year over Year





### **Homelessness by Population Type**







### Age Distribution of Single Adults






