What is the PIT Count?

The Point-in-Time (PIT) Count provides a snapshot of the individuals and families experiencing homelessness in a geographical area, over the course of one night.

How will the Count be done?

Groups of volunteers will be out looking for people who are unhoused in areas where the unhoused shelter and congregate. They will be approaching those they meet and asking to conduct a survey. Giveaways may also be available.



How does taking the Survey help?

Participating in the survey will help plan for resources and services for those experiencing homelessness in our Community. The data is used to help Montgomery County in our effort to end homelessness. HUD requires the count to determine the allocation of funding to Communities. Those experiencing homelessness who participate in the survey will be sharing their voice and point of view to this important effort.
