 - Data Analysis
 - Phillip Robinson summarized data pulled by Aemish Rao from the CFPB complaint database. Aemish compiled all Maryland complaints from 2023 and filtered them by Montgomery County zip codes, showing various issue categories, products, and subproducts. Pivot tables compared CFPB complaints in Montgomery County to the rest of the state, providing insight into local issues.

 - Educational Programming
 - The subcommittee generated a list of potential program ideas. They are also working to create materials for an event during Hispanic Heritage month.
