#### **Montgomery County Office of the Inspector General Issues Progress Report**

Rockville, Maryland – Montgomery County Maryland Inspector General Megan Davey Limarzi announced today the release of the Office of the Inspector General’s (OIG) [mid-year status report](#) on progress made to address recommendations issued by the OIG from July 1, 2025 to March 1, 2026. The report was issued in support of the OIG’s mission to increase accountability and transparency in county-funded programs and operations.

The report details the status of the 84 recommendations, which were the result of 20 audits, reviews, and investigations that yielded opportunities for improvement within the scope of the report. The report highlights the positive actions taken by the affected entities including the fact that 46 of the 84 recommendations have been addressed, and 7 of the engagements have been closed outright - meaning all recommendations have been fully implemented.

Additionally, the information detailed in the report points to the OIG’s continued impact on improving County programs and operations. It also documents the commitment of County leaders and their teams to improving the efficiency and effectiveness of County government and Montgomery County Public Schools.
