Dear Mr Finkel, Mr Chappell, Mr Goodfriend, Mr. Mack, Mrs. Bennett & Mrs. Jaitly:

As you can see by this email I am going to try again to build a handicapped adu. In February of 2023 I broke my right collarbone falling at the school I volunteer at. My hand was in a sling which prohibited tying my shoe which results in another fall breaking my right ankle, tibia and fibula the following week. I was immobile for over six months and I could not even gain entrance to my bedroom door which was too tiny for my wheelchair. Approximately sixty five days again and broke my patella, femur and tibia (will send all documentation). Before I even applied for an adu last year the surgeon, Paul Cooper who previously replaced my left ankle with titanium the year I retired at sixty-eight suggests totally handicapped living facility based on my "mushy" bones and the likelihood of continuing breaks. Since Montgomery County promotes aging in place with an adu this seemed like my best option.

I am currently in a small fishing village in Mallorca admiring the houses that have been in the family for generations and noting the quality and craftsmanship of my father's handiwork on the house he built for his family. The children are privileged to adopt from both Montgomery County Social Services and Catholic Charities do not have a home that would provide them and my grandchildren with that stability. This would help them upon my demise and keep it in the

I read the documentation from last year's hearing and have lived in my house the required time for principal residence and have retained and paid Sean Patrick Hughes of Miller, Miller and Canby to represent me if it again goes to a

This is to keep you apprised of the main reason for the construction of this adu.
