The repairs to the curb and gutter started two weeks ago with six pieces of curb being replaced. After that occurred, the crew came back the following day to remove the wood boarding so that the affected homeowners could use their driveway.

I just got confirmation this morning that the paving company has moved the top coat of paving until next Tuesday at 7:30 am after they finish a job tomorrow they have been working on for two weeks. I am updating everything once again to reflect the work planned and in process.

When three pieces of curb were replace on the "T" turnaround at the end, the adjoining pervious pavers were pulled up to pour the concrete. Yesterday Mike got his 3 workers to show up to replace the pervious pavers and they are there today finishing up fixing several spots of pervious pavers. There is no equipment onsite and just 3 people fixing the pavers.

What I am trying to coordinate today is the removal of multiple pieces of sidewalk in the public right of way. As soon as I hear, I will be notifying Josh and Greg by text and the right of way inspector and the neighborhood because equipment will be onsite to jackhammer the concrete.

I am waiting to hear from Mike when he is bringing the Bobcat to the site to finish moving the stockpile at the second entrance. We have also discussed starting excavating the subgrade for the pervious sidewalk in the playground area and I am waiting on the timing for that to start in the next couple of days.

Mike Hines is using his own time and his crews from other jobs to split their time so that he has control over the work being done and control over the costs. I have been out there myself setting forms, delivering stone and working next to him to get the job done. We have make numerous trips to Home Depot and Contractor's Supply to rent equipment and purchase materials. We are doing a lot of the work ourselves to control the work product and costs.
