## Nutrient Management Planning: Next Steps

While you wait, you can gather the needed information for your plan. You cannot be placed on the waiting list until all the information is provided.

The following information will be needed to complete your plan (some information may not be applicable to certain operations):

1. A current (less than 3 years old at time of nutrient application) soil analysis for each field or management unit
2. Any change in field maps (field names and numbers should match soil tests; maps can be obtained from the county Farm Service Agency or online through websites such as Google Earth)
3. Field Data
  - a. Anticipated crop(s) for each field for the upcoming crop year
  - b. Previous crop(s) including cover crops and manure history
4. Poultry and/or livestock data
  - a. All livestock (including equine) and poultry should be included
  - b. Animal numbers including approximate weights
  - c. Bedding used
  - d. Hours confined
  - e. Manure management (i.e. hauled away by whom, spread on fields, stockpiled, etc.)
5. Additional analyses may be necessary depending on crops or nutrient source.
