The Doctor will perform a physical exam on the patient prior to surgery, pre-op pain injections or topical medication is included in the price. A small blood panel may be done at no extra cost if the Doctor feels it is necessary. After review of the results, the patient may or may not be a candidate for surgery.

We recommend all patients go home with pain medication and an e-collar to assist and prevent issues while healing at home, but these items can be declined during the surgery consult at drop off.

Dental radiographs will be done on all patients as a standard and are included in the price. Pain medication and antibiotics to go home are not included and will be additional to the listed price. For patients over the age of 6 years old or patients with pre-existing conditions we may require additional tests prior to surgery to ensure patient is a good surgery candidate. Any additional testing is not included in the price above.

**We require a \$100 deposit for basic cleaning dental procedures from any patient not owned by a rescue/shelter, and a \$300 deposit for full mouth extractions. Deposits are non-refundable.
