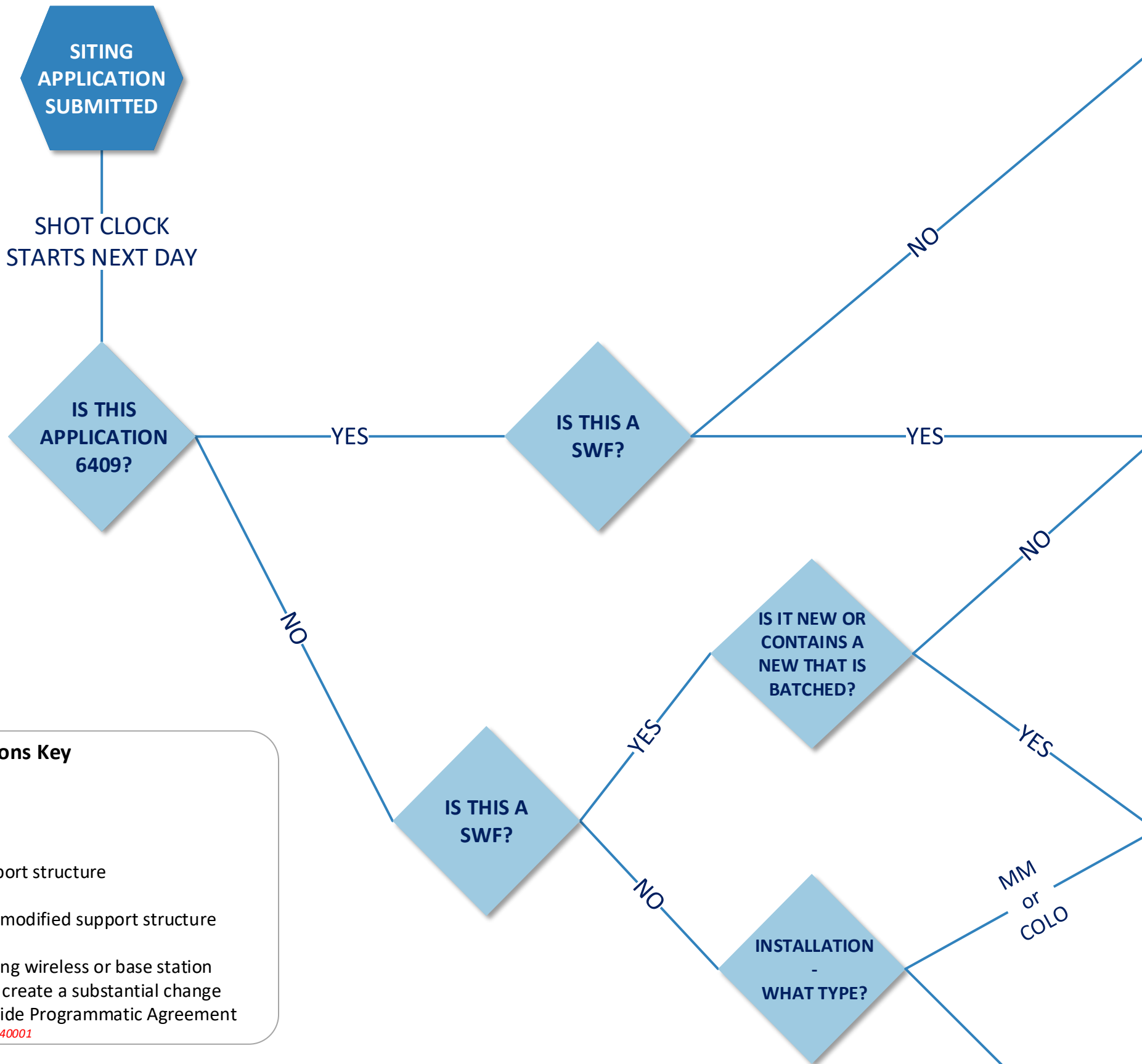


FCC SHOT CLOCK PROCESS



MUST ACT WITHIN 60 DAYS

- 30 DAYS TO NOTIFY APPLICANT IF INFORMATION IS MISSING
- 10 DAYS TO CONTACT IF INFORMATION IS STILL MISSING

MUST ACT WITHIN 60 DAYS

- 10 DAYS TO NOTIFY APPLICANT IF INFORMATION IS MISSING
- SHOT CLOCK THEN RESETS TO 60 DAYS ONCE AFTER SUPPLEMENTAL SUBMITTAL
- 10 DAYS TO CONTACT IF INFORMATION IS STILL MISSING

MUST ACT WITHIN 90 DAYS

- 30 DAYS TO NOTIFY APPLICANT IF INFORMATION IS MISSING
- 10 DAYS TO CONTACT IF INFORMATION IS STILL MISSING

MUST ACT WITHIN 150 DAYS

- 30 DAYS TO NOTIFY APPLICANT IF INFORMATION IS MISSING
- 10 DAYS TO CONTACT IF INFORMATION IS STILL MISSING

Abbreviations Key

SWF	Small Wireless Facility
MM	Minor Modification
NEW	New or replacement support structure
COLO	Colocation on existing or modified support structure
6409	Modification to any existing wireless or base station installation that does not create a substantial change according to the Nationwide Programmatic Agreement <i>See 47 CFR § 1.40001</i>

- “Substantial Change” is**
- Height increase greater than 10%/20ft/array height for towers; 10%/10ft for other structures
 - Width increase greater than 20ft from edge of a tower; 6ft from edge of an other structure
 - More than 4 equipment cabinets
 - Excavation outside the “site”
 - Defeats the concealments efforts
- See 47 CFR § 1.40001*

- “Small Wireless Facility” must be**
- On a structure no taller than 50 feet; or on a replaced or modified structure no taller than 10 percent taller than surrounding structures or a preexisting height
 - Have the volumetric limits are equal or less than - 3 cubic feet for the antenna(s) and 28 cubic feet for wireless equipment associated with the antenna
 - Does not require an antenna structure registration
 - Not located on tribal lands
 - Does not exceeds RF exposure limits under FCC Rule 1.1307(b)
