Co-location by Special Exception:

7. T-Mobile application to attach antennas at the 35'-high level atop a 24'-high building on National Children's Center property located at 410 University Boulevard West in Silver Spring (Application #200908-22).

Note: This application was recommended by the TFCG in 2010 conditioned on obtaining approval of a Special Exception by the Board of Appeals. According to the Zoning Ordinance requirements in effect at that time, the applicant was required to provide a copy of the TFCG recommendation, not more than a year old, with their application for the special exception. That recommendation will be a year old on March 3, 2011. Consequently, the applicant has requested a second review and action by the TFCG to obtain a current TFCG recommendation to attach to the special exception application which they are now ready to file.

The applicant explains that the filing for the special exception was delayed due to resolution of issues related to a change in ownership of the property and the lease agreement. A copy of the Record of Action, attachments, and an excerpt of the minutes from the 2010 TFCG meeting are attached for reference. Based on statements from the applicant and our review of the current plans, no changes have been made to the details of the application the TFCG reviewed it. Based on a recent site visit and search of the TFCG database we find nothing to warrant any different recommendation than what the TFCG made at that time. Accordingly, our recommendation is as the TFCG recommended the application when first reviewed:

Conditioned on the Board of Appeals approving a Special Exception, Administrative modification to the existing Special Exception or whatever other applicable action may be deemed appropriate by the Board for placement of these facilities.

New Construction by Special Exception:

8. IMF application for an AT&T 155'-high monopole with panel antennas at the 150' level on IMF property located at 15700 River Road in Germantown (Application #201103-02).

Conditioned on applicant being granted a special exception by the Board of Appeals for a monopole not to exceed 130 feet in height or lower.

9. T-Mobile application to attach antennas at the 147' level on a 155'-high monopole on Ammerman property located at 19100 Wasche Road in Dickerson. (Application #201103-07).

Conditioned on approval of a special exception by the Board of Appeals.
