
### 2021 COVID-19 RENTAL RELIEF: PROCESS UPDATE (JULY 26)

### 65% SPENDING TARGET TRACKER











### SHELTER RESIDENTS: AVERAGE DAILY COUNT BY WEEK





### MC311 WEEKLY CALL VOLUME










### VACCINATION COUNTS: CHANGE OVER TIME AND BY AGE GROUP









### VACCINATION GAPS AND DIFFERENTIALS BY GEOGRAPHY AND RACE/ETH


