
Denials are primarily due to applicants not having a covid financial hardship, seeking mortgage support, exceeding income requirements or not demonstrating county residence.



SELF-REPORTED CHARACTERISTICS

- 49% OF TENANT APPLICANTS MATCHED WITH LANDLORD APPLICATION
- **54**% UNEMPLOYED PAST 90 DAYS
- **27%** NEEDED TO CARE FOR SELF/OTHERS
- **25**% RECEIVED EVICTION NOTICE (SELF-REPORTED)













SHELTER RESIDENTS: AVERAGE DAILY COUNT BY WEEK





MC311 WEEKLY CALL VOLUME








COVID-19 VACCINATION SUMMARY

As of 12.14.21, DHHS has limited access to information on COVID cases and vaccinations other than publicly available data due to the security incident at the Maryland Department of Health last week. Depicted below are vaccination data from the CDC, extracted on 12.14.21.

% OF ALL COUNTY RESIDENTS VACCINATED AT LEAST 1 DOSE 95% OF TOTAL POPULATION 994,439 Data points above posted on CDC site on 12,14,21

- Montgomery County continues to rank #1
 <u>nationwide</u> for % of 12+ population <u>fully</u> vaccinated among all US counties with >300K residents.
- The county ranks 7th among all US counties with >300K residents for % of 5+ population <u>fully</u> vaccinated.



The percentages of 12-17 year olds and 5-11 year olds vaccinated are reported as 90% confidence range because of higher margin of errors within these age groups. According to the CDC, as of 12.14.21, 85,937 12-17 year olds received at least 1 dose, and 75,881 received a complete series. Among 5-11 year olds, 42,944 received at least one dose, and 25,219 received a complete series.


