Item 1 & 2 – Introductions/Minutes: Members and guests introduced themselves. Meeting minutes were tabled.

Item 3 – Vision Zero Presentation: Wade Holland, MCDOT CountyStat Analyst, provided an overview of the County’s Vision Zero plan to reduce traffic fatalities.

Mr. Holland explained the features of Vision Zero v. the traditional approach by planners:

<u>Vision Zero</u>	<u>Traditional Approach</u>
<i>Traffic deaths are preventable</i>	<i>Traffic deaths are inevitable</i>
<i>Integrate human failing in approach</i>	<i>Perfect human behavior</i>
<i>Prevent fatal and severe crashes</i>	<i>Prevent collisions</i>
<i>Adopt a systems approach</i>	<i>Rely on individual responsibility</i>
<i>Saving lives is not expensive</i>	<i>Saving lives is expensive</i>

Through creation of “complete streets” that provide for pedestrian safety with HAWK beacons, pedestrian scramble intersections with all traffic stopped, protected bike lanes, signal timing and adequate lighting, the County’s goal is to achieve 100 percent reduction in severe and fatal collisions by 2030. The County Executive’s Pedestrian Safety Initiative, launched in 2007, has resulted in the steady decline of severe and fatal collisions, from a high of 15.1 per 100K in 2006, to 5.0 per 100K in 2016. Vision Zero will provide an improved framework going forward.
