






TYPICAL SECTIONS: WINDHAM LANE TO PRICHARD ROAD








TYPICAL SECTIONS: PRICHARD ROAD TO REEDIE DRIVE








TYPICAL SECTIONS: REEDIE DRIVE TO BLUERIDGE AVENUE















TYPICAL SECTIONS: BLUERIDGE AVENUE TO ARCOLA AVENUE



COST AND ASSESSMENTS

- Total project cost currently estimated at \$5,900,000.
- Project Cost includes:
 - Planning and Engineering
 - Land Acquisition (Fee simple; Perpetual Easement and Temporary Construction Easements)
 - Utility Relocations
 - Construction
 - Construction Management
