SUBJECT: Dale Drive Pedestrian Improvements project

On June 10 the T&E Committee reviewed the results of first phase of facility planning for this project. The Committee recommends that the Department of Transportation proceed to the next phase of facility planning with the north-side sidepath option and the Alternative 1 (Realignment) of the Dale Drive/Columbia Boulevard/Corwin Drive/Woodland Drive intersection. The Committee also recommends that DOT evaluate the Planning Board's other recommendations during the next phase of planning: more crosswalks, tighter geometric improvements to intersection of Dale Drive and Grace Church Road, and a better connection for bicyclists and pedestrians for the master-planned Woodland Drive Greenway.

The Committee appreciates the work the Department of Transportation has completed for this study, especially the efforts of John "JT" Thomas and Angel Cheng.
