

Public Workshop Comments

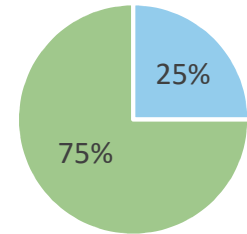

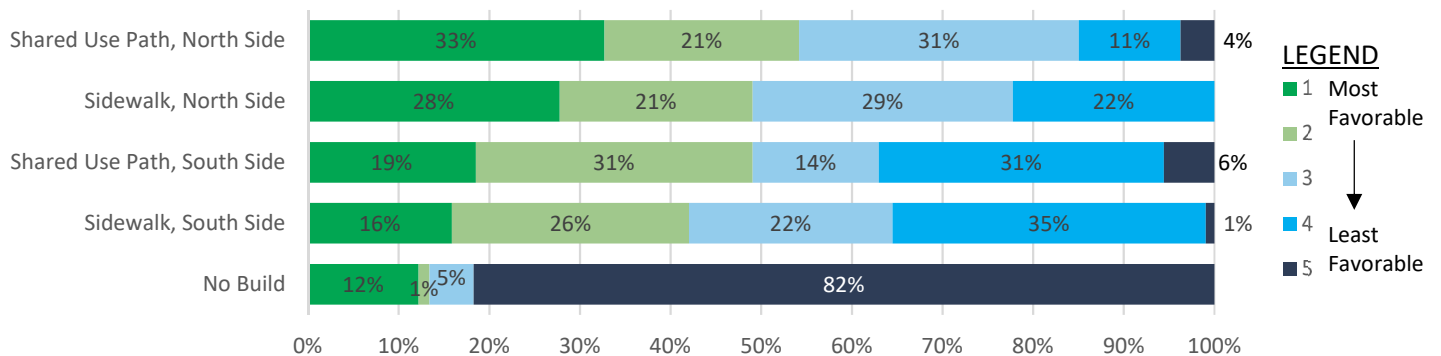
25% of respondents live on Dale Drive

75% of respondents do not live on Dale Drive



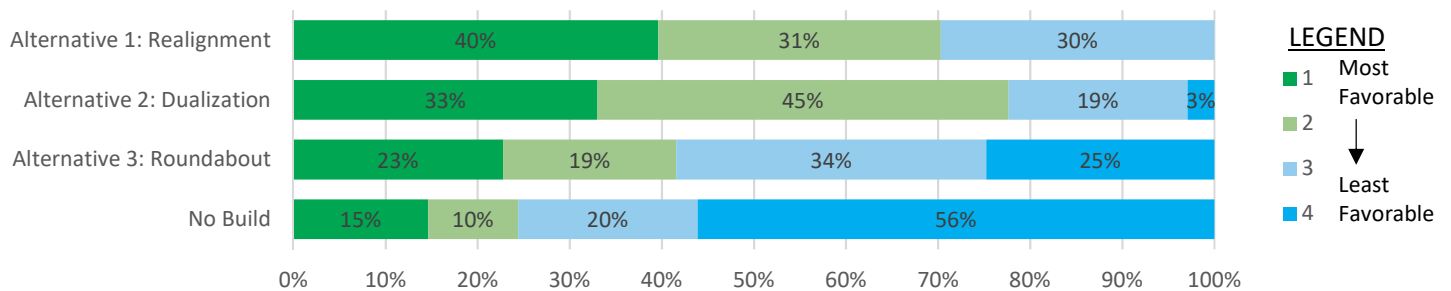
Corridor Concept Ranking:

The options on the north side of the road are preferred over those on the south side of the road. The shared use path options are preferred over the sidewalk options on the same side of the road. The majority of respondents support building a facility of some kind as opposed to the no-build option.



Intersection Alternative Ranking:

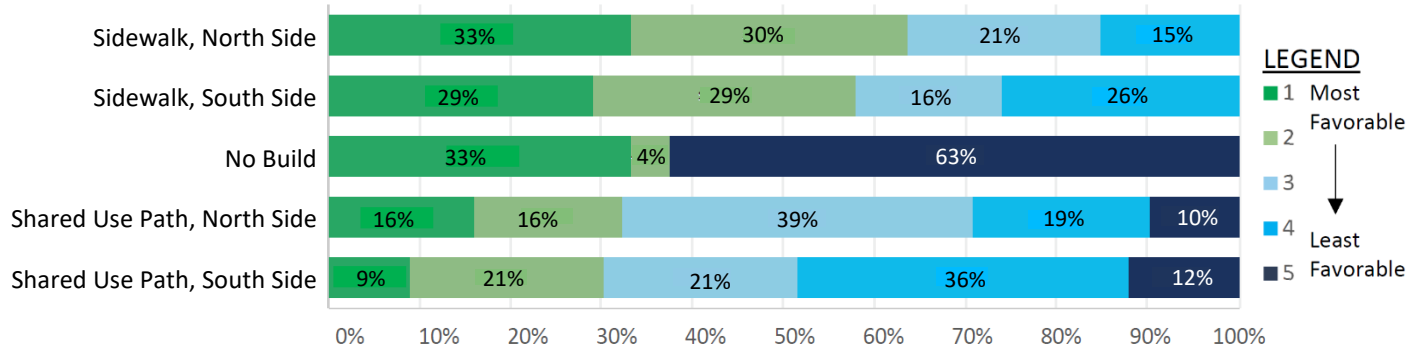
Alternative 1: Realignment was the most preferred alternative. The majority of respondents support an intersection improvement as opposed to the no-build option.



Other Common Responses: (in no particular order)

- Drainage and Stormwater Management concerns along the corridor
- Maintain on-street parking on Dale Drive
- Concerns about visibility for vehicles entering and exiting driveways
- Reduce Speed on Dale Drive
- Maintain Character of Dale Drive
- Additional Improvements at Dale Drive and Grace Church Road
