Please be advised that the Property Acquisition Section of the Montgomery County
Department of Transportation (MCDOT), pursuant to Montgomery County Code section 4962(e), has received Executive Order No. 066-23 (attached) authorizing a Public Hearing to
consider an application for abandonment received from Montgomery County Department of
Transportation, Division of Transportation Engineering (the "Applicant"), for the
abandonment of 2 portions of public right of way over Potomac Edison's property located on
the west side of Frederick Road (MD355) across from the intersection of Brink Road, in
Clarksburg Maryland, 20871. The easements are for a Perpetual Easement for a Bike Path
covering approximately 2,655 square feet and a Perpetual Easement for a Drainage Facility
covering approximately 388 square feet. The petition seeks to abandon these portions of the
right of way, which was established based on an initial design. Subsequent to the original Bike
Path and Drainage Facility Easement Agreement's recordation, the bike path's design was
modified, resulting in a realignment of the bike path and drainage facilities across the
Potomac Edison property. Additional easements were acquired as needed.

If approved, it will allow the Applicant to extinguish the superfluous easement areas.
