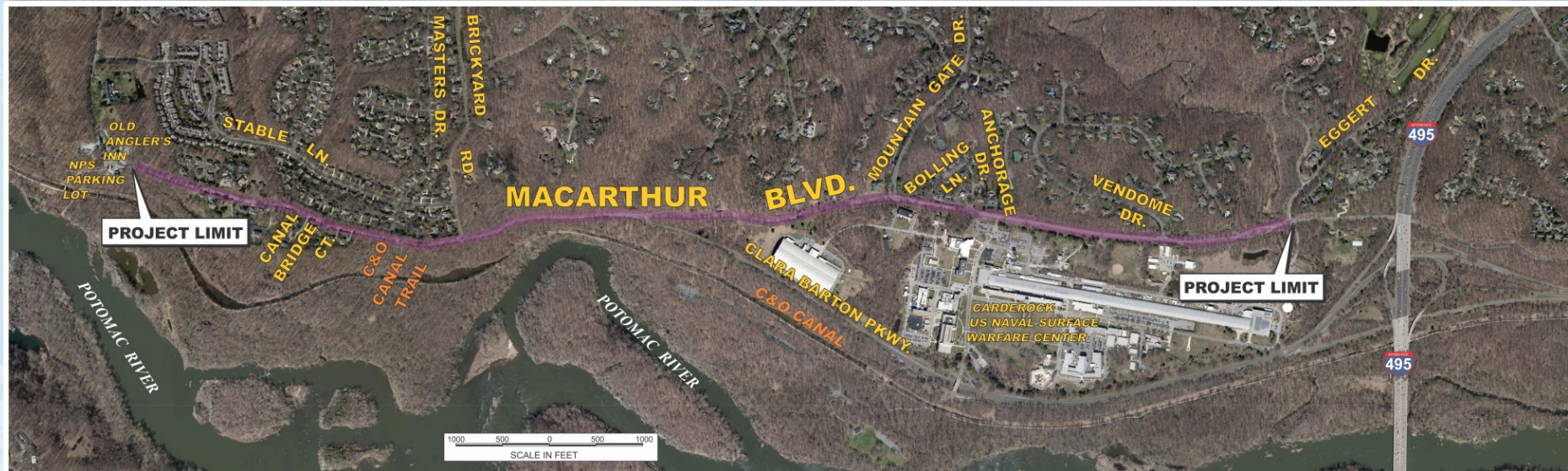

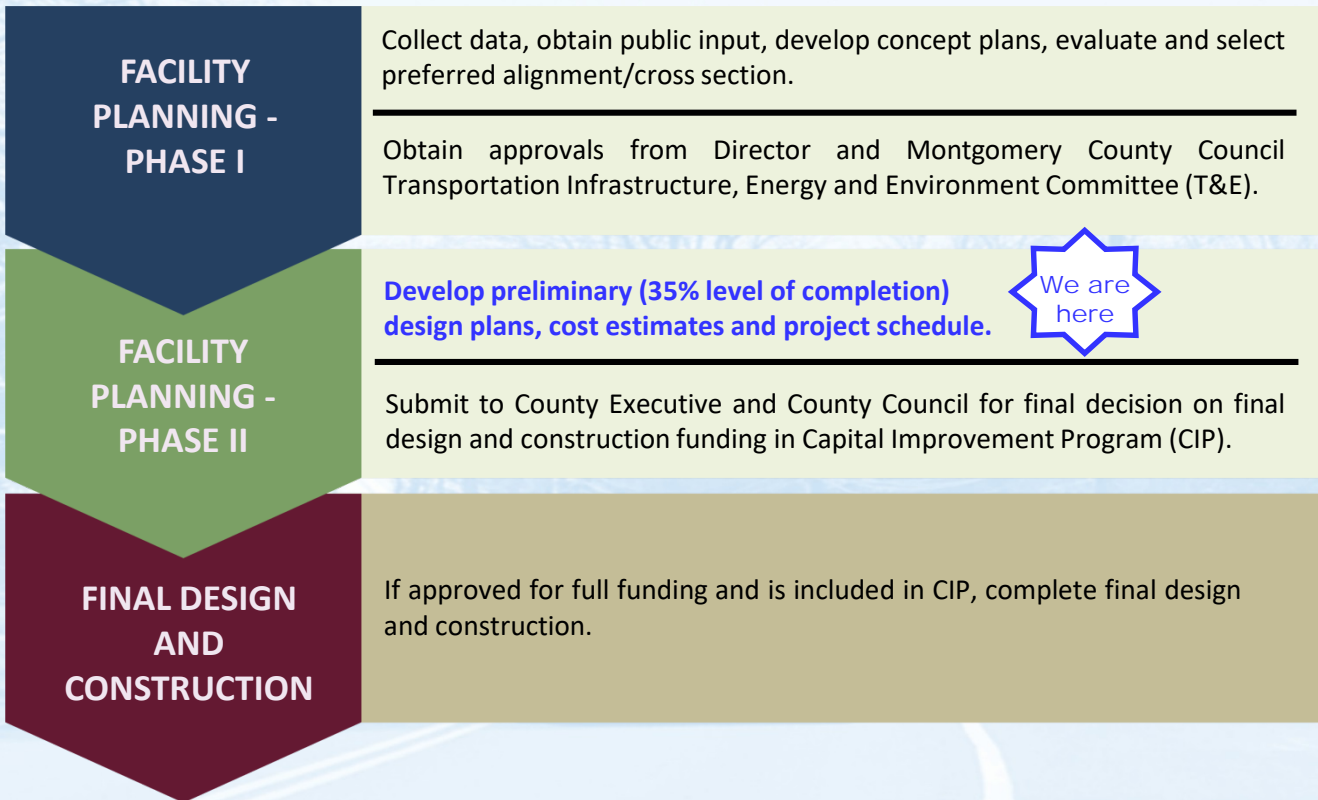

- » Improve safety of bicycling on MacArthur Boulevard to better serve the bicyclists of all ages and abilities



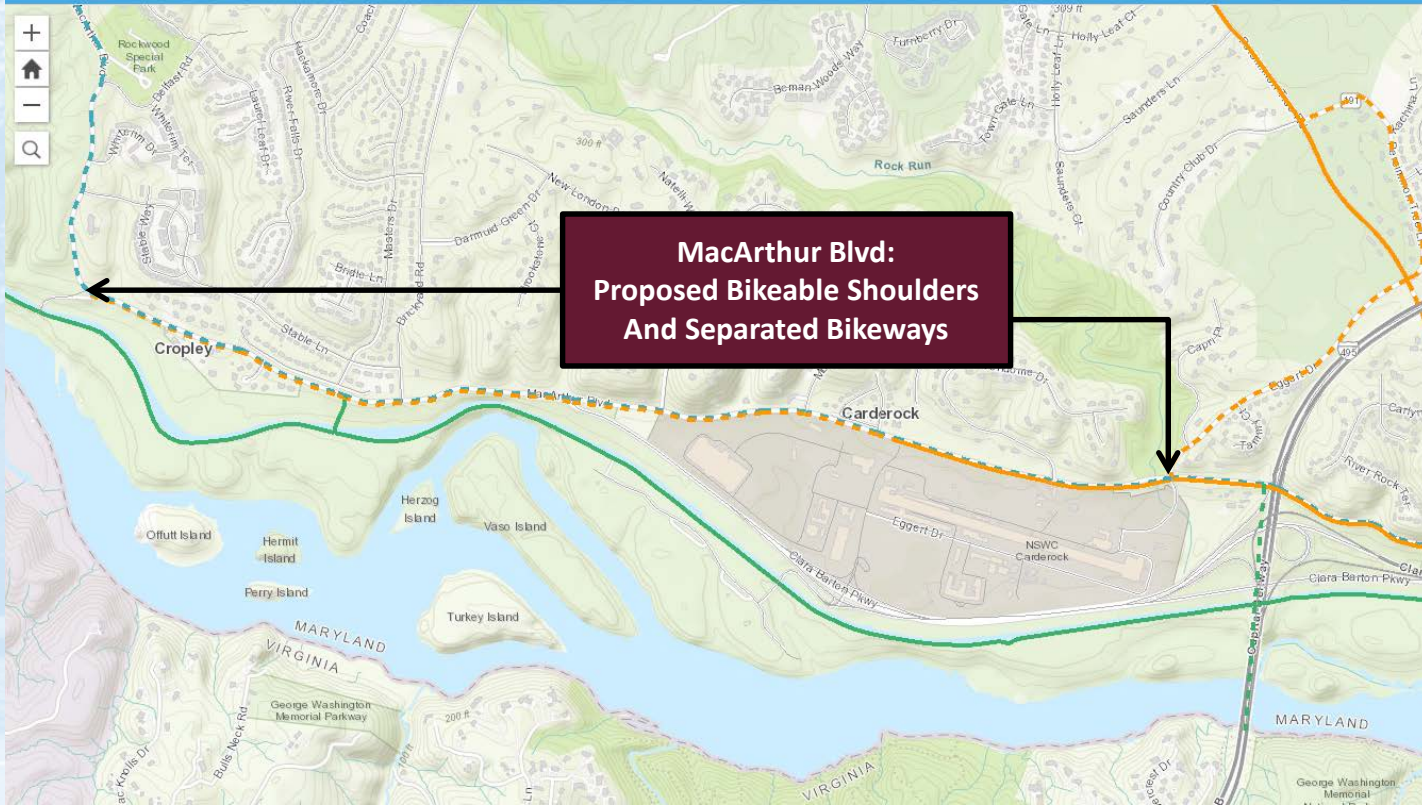

THE BICYCLE MASTER PLAN PROPOSED BICYCLE NETWORK

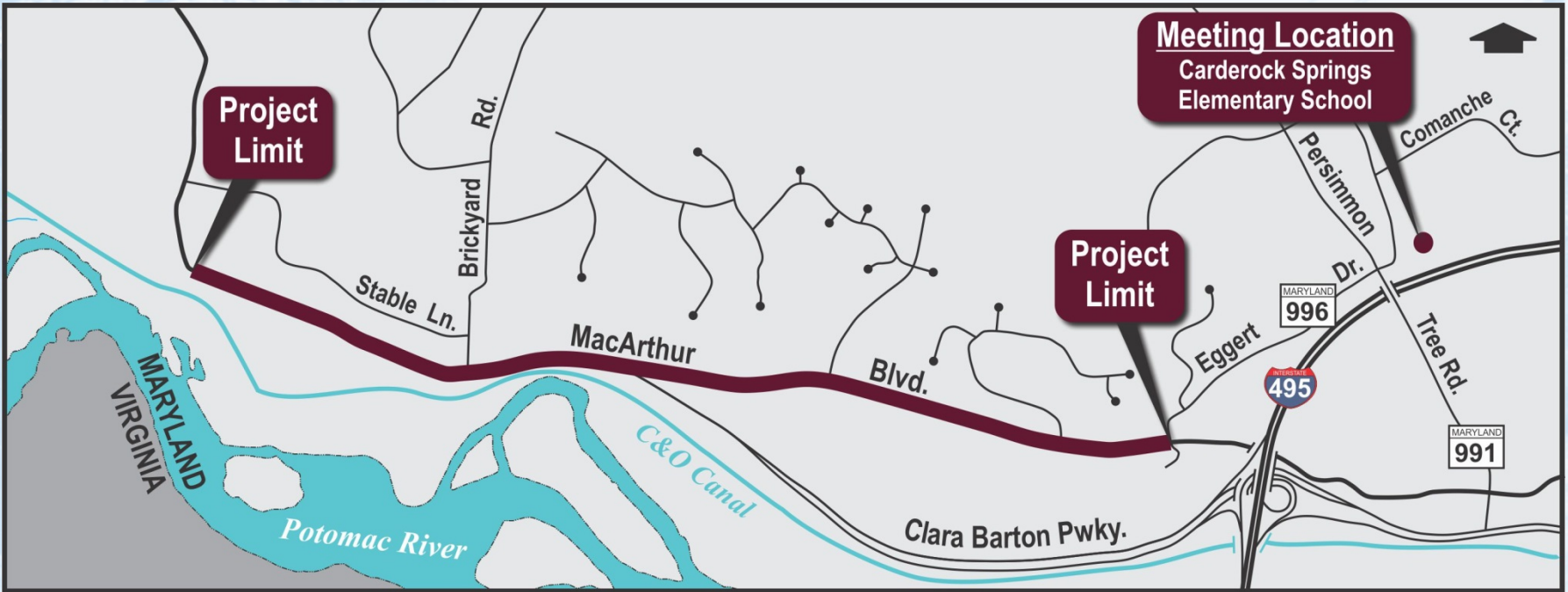

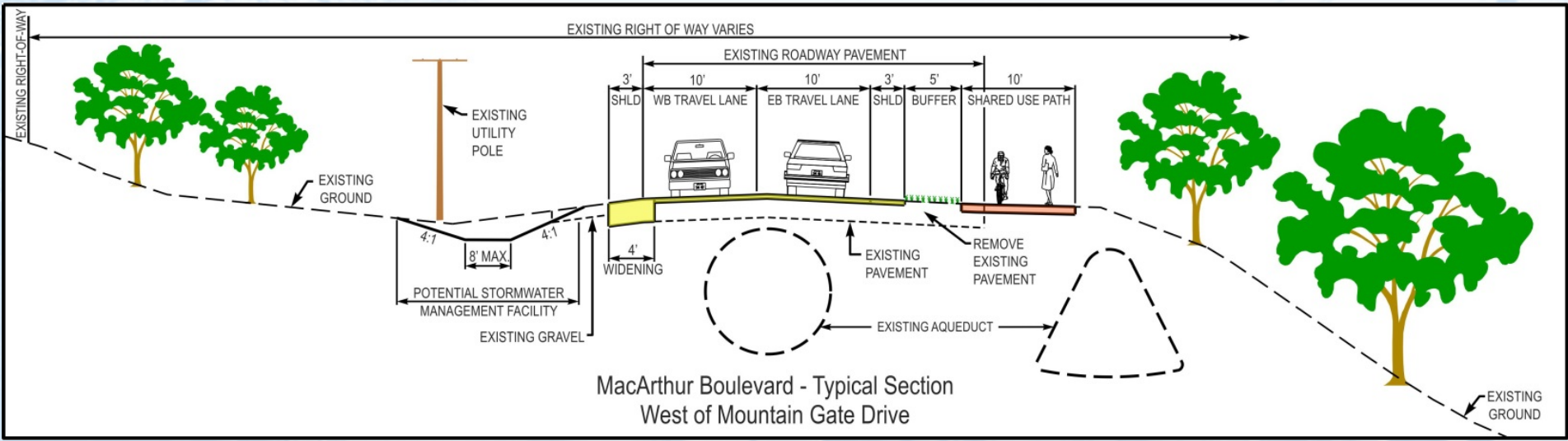

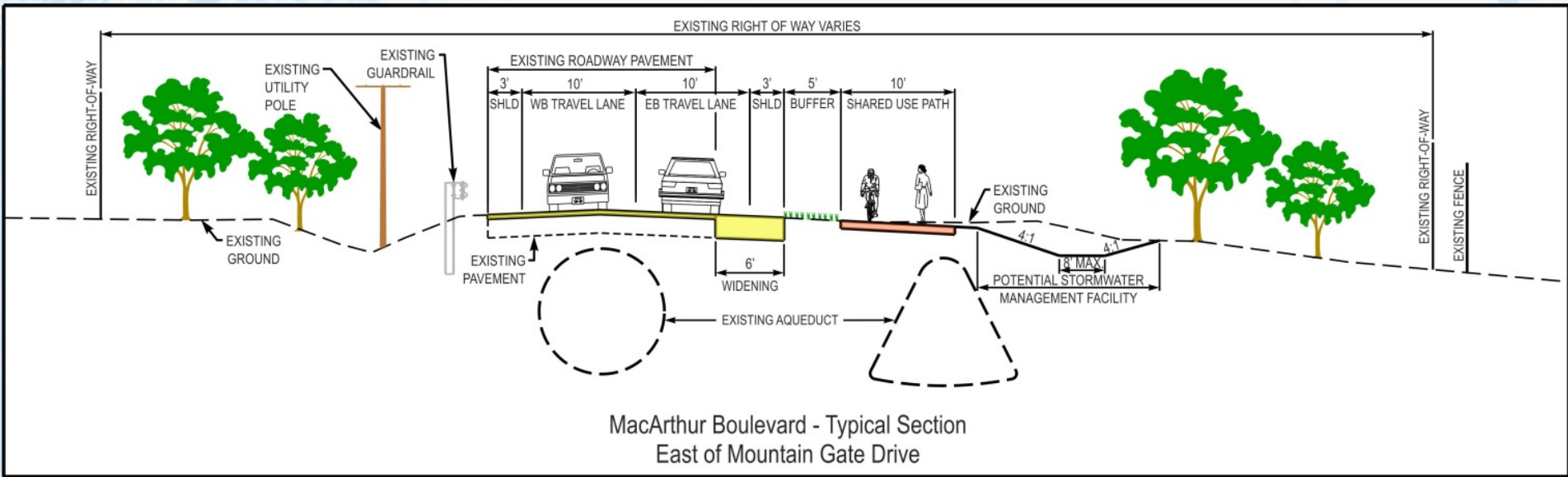
ROADWAY SECTION

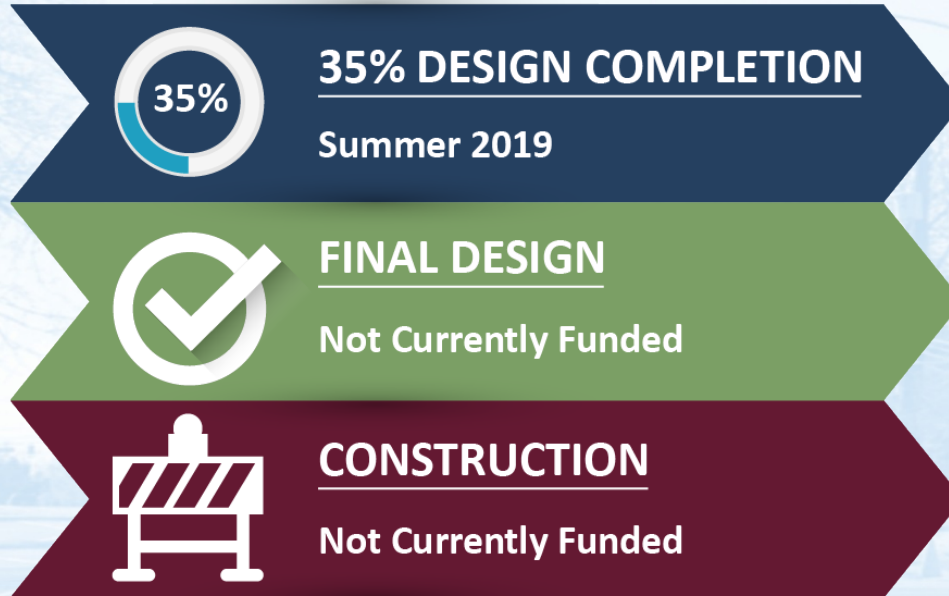
