

- Extend North High Street to Morningwood Drive
- Provide pedestrians & cyclists access from Morningwood Drive
- Identify additional safety improvement needs

Existing Conditions

- Roadway width: varies 12' to 40'
- Right of Way width: varies 30' to 80'
- Access from Morningwood Drive
 - Pedestrians stairs, not ADA-compliant
 - Cyclists none
 - Drivers none
- Street parking on both side
- Intermittent sidewalk on south side
- Zoning: Mixed use





 - 5' sidewalk with buffer, 6' sidewalk adjacent to curb

NORTH HIGH STREET EXTENSION - TYPICAL SECTIONS (APRIL 2024)







Project Cost and Impacts

- Construction Cost
 - Preliminary (35%) Design Cost Estimate: \$900,000
- Right-of-Way Impacts
 - Proposed Right-of-Way Required: 2,400 SF
 - Temporary Construction Easement Required: 10,300 SF
 - Impacted Properties: 16





Project Schedule

- 35% Design Milestone: Q1 2024
- Public Meeting: Q2 2024
- Mandatory Referral: Q2 2024
- 70% design Milestone: Q3 2024
- Public Hearing: Q4 2024
- Final Design Complete: Q4 2024
- Property Acquisition Process Begins: Q1 2025
- Utility Relocation Begins: Q2 2025 (Estimated)
- Construction Begins: Q3 2025 (Estimated)
