Purple Line Piney Branch Station Sidewalk Proposal Approved

Dear Residents:

After a complete review of all comments provided in response to the Purple Line Piney Branch Road Station sidewalk proposal, the Montgomery County Department of Transportation (MCDOT), Division of Transportation Engineering's Sidewalk Program has approved and authorized the installation of sidewalks on Glenville Road, Langley Drive, Quebec Street, Tahona Drive, Osage Street, and Gilbert Street.

Similarly, the Safe Routes to Schools Program within the Division of Traffic Engineering and Operations has approved the installation of the proposed sidewalks on **Ludlow Street** and **Hudson Avenue**.

Please see the finalized plans on the project website to view the exact locations and configurations of the approved sidewalks. For your ease, a QR code to the project website is provided to the right. Also, because Langley Drive intersects with University Boulevard, a state roadway, we are awaiting the State's final approval of the installations there, which we anticipate in the coming days. Upon approval, the finalized plans for Langley Drive will be uploaded to the project website for your review.



Weather permitting, construction is anticipated to begin on or around October 1st, 2025. A detailed construction notice will be sent separately in the coming days. In addition, MCDOT will delineate the excavation site and post signs prior to starting construction. An inspector will be on-site and available throughout the entire construction process to address any concerns you may have.
