

At an upcoming virtual public hearing, residents will have an opportunity to present oral and/or written comments concerning the abandonment of a public alley covering an approximately 301 S.F. parcel located at 4803 Bayard Boulevard, Bethesda, MD 20816 further depicted in the attached aerial map. The abandonment case was petitioned by Benjamin and Michele Oshman (the "Applicant"). The petition seeks to abandon the Public Alley on the basis that there is no current or anticipated future public use of the alley.

The [Montgomery County Department of Transportation](#) (MCDOT) will hold the virtual public hearing on Wednesday, September 21st beginning at 1:00 p.m. on the internet-based platform Zoom. The public has until 5 p.m., Friday, September 16th to register to participate in the hearing. Those previously registered to attend the Hearing are not required to re-register.
