At an upcoming virtual public hearing, residents will have an opportunity to present oral and/or written comments concerning the abandonment of a portion of public right of way covering approximately 3,405 square feet of the public right of way known as Northfield Road that abuts their properties at 8401 Moorland and 5423 Northfield Road (the "Abandonment Area") located at the northwest corner of 11565 Old Georgetown Road Rockville, MD 20852 further depicted in the attached aerial and exhibit map. The abandonment case was petitioned by Bradley and Sophie Buslik (the "Applicants"). The petition seeks to abandon the Public Right of Way on the basis that there is no current or anticipated future public use for the property. The [Montgomery County Department of Transportation](#)

(MCDOT) will hold the virtual public hearing on Monday, July 24 2023 beginning at 1:00 p.m. on the internet-based platform Zoom. Registration
