### NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING PERMANENT CLOSURE OF N.W. TERMINUS OF WESTBARD AVE. AT RIVER RD. AB 786

Pursuant to Section 49-62 of the Montgomery County Code (2014) as amended, the County Executive or his Designee shall conduct a virtual Public Hearing via the internet-based platform known as Zoom on **Tuesday, September 19, 2023 at 2:00 PM**, to consider an application from 5500 Westbard Avenue Block Civic Association (the "Applicant"), for the permanent closure of a public right of way at the northwestern terminus of Westbard Avenue at River Road in the Westbard area of Bethesda. The Applicant requests permanent closure of the right of way from all vehicular traffic, including emergency vehicles, at the intersection. The petition also requests that a temporary closure remain in place until a permanent closure can be installed.

Scanning the QR Code with your mobile device will direct you to the registration form required to participate. Completing the registration form ensures you receive an electronic invitation to participate in the Hearing. Registration for this Public Hearing will close on **Friday, September 15, 2023, at 5:00 PM**.



After the Hearing, the Hearing Officer shall report his findings and recommendations to the County Executive for further consideration as prescribed by the County Code. Ultimately, it is the County Council who will make the final decision on the petition.
