Good Morning,

Please be advised that the Property Acquisition Section of the Montgomery County Department of Transportation (MCDOT), pursuant to Montgomery County Code section 49-62(e), has received Executive Order No. 063-24 (attached) authorizing a Public Hearing to consider an application for abandonment received from Coey Salsberg and Sandra Salsberg (the "Applicant"), to abandon a portion of public right of way covering approximately 4,500 square feet, more or less, of the public right of way known as Broad Street that abuts their property at 6401 Broad Street, in Bethesda Maryland, 20816. The right of way to be abandoned was dedicated to public use in 1925 by Subdivision Plat. No. 305 entitled "Section No. 1 Brookmont." While the right of way was anticipated for public vehicular, use, the right of way currently terminates in a stub that is functioning as the sole driveway to the Applicant's property. Having never been constructed to public use standards, the Abandonment Area is a gravel road that, according to their Applicant, has never been maintained by the County. The Abandonment Area is being sought because the applicant has been maintaining the area at their own expense and wishes to continue maintaining it.
