

Project Origin

- Shady Grove Sector Plan, 2006
 - Connection from Crabbs Branch Way to Amity Drive
 - Primary Residential Street
 - Bike Path
 - Sidewalk

Crabbs Branch Way

Crabbs Branch Way is a significant travel route through the planning area from Gude Drive to Shady Grove Road. It provides access to residential areas, the Metro station and the County Service Park. The road does not extend north of I-370 although a bridge under I-370 was built in anticipation of such an extension. This Plan recommends:

 Extending Crabbs Branch Way with an 80-foot right-of-way, under I-370 to Amity Drive, to improve local connections. To discourage cut-through traffic, a traffic circle should be considered at the intersection of Crabbs Branch Way and Amity Drive. Additional traffic calming measures along Amity Drive should also be considered.




The 2006 Shady Grove Sector Plan recommended the extension of Crabbs Branch Way to Amity Drive, which is currently under facility planning by MCDOT.




Phase 1 Study Alternatives – Parallel Efforts

• Washington Grove Trail Connection Options



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

Washington Grove Connector Alternative #3 (Brown Street) should be advanced as the preferred trail alignment. This trail should be designed to county typical standards, including a trail width of ten feet with 2-foot wide unpaved, graded shoulders, and with no obstructions within two feet of the trail edge. We concur with Alternative #3 as the most cost-effective and therefore practicable and desirable alignment in the near term, and we support connectivity through the Meadow. We also concur with the planned inclusion of the Picea Court Connector as an additional bicycle/pedestrian improvement, either as part of this project or as a separate project.

A paved trail connection between Amity Drive and Crabbs Branch Way should be built in the interim (until the Crabbs Branch Way Extension project is constructed) along the planned Crabbs Branch way Extension alignment.


Attachment: Staff report to the Planning Board, July 20, 2023 The traffic analysis conducted for the Crabbs Branch Way Extension project supports the master planned road extension.

MCDOT should prioritize construction of the Brown Street Connector portion of the Washington Grove Connector project, as this segment of the overall project has substantial public support, including from the Town of Washington Grove, is far along in the design process, and has a relatively low cost.

MCDOT should continue to advance development of a trail through Piedmont Crossing Local Park to Amity Drive. If the Council decides to fund construction of the Crabbs Branch Road Extension, this trail should be constructed adjacent to the roadway. Any trail alignments pursued are required to proceed through Montgomery Parks Concept Review process and receive Park Construction Permit Review and Approval prior to any construction.

Picea View Court Connection


- Provides pedestrian and bike connection from Picea

- Paves an existing foot path in this location




Washington Grove Connector Trail - Plan View



Trail Cross Section




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
Trail Lighting




