Summary: This temporary regulation extends the sunset date of the Montgomery County Personnel Regulations for 90 days, from January 5, 2014 to April 5, 2014.

Background: The Montgomery County Code Chapter 2A-15(j) of the Administrative Procedures Act provides authority to issue temporary regulations for a period of not more than 90 days without meeting the publication and approval requirements if a public or fiscal emergency requires its adoption, or the public interest will be materially harmed if the regulation does not take effect immediately.

Section 1. Purpose

Executive Regulation No.26-07AM, Comprehensive Amendments to the 2001 Montgomery County Personnel Regulations, changed the sunset date of the Montgomery County Personnel Regulations from October 7, 2008 to January 5, 2014. The Office of Human Resources has


been reviewing the current Personnel Regulations in order to better meet the needs of the County workforce, correct any unintended effects of the language used in the current regulations, and improve the administration of the merit system. Executive Regulation 16-13, the proposed Comprehensive Amendments to the Montgomery County Personnel Regulations, which includes a provision establishing a new date for the Personnel Regulations to sunset, will be transmitted to the Council after it has been advertised for comment in the *Montgomery County Register*. The sunset date is being extended by temporary regulation in order to allow the Council sufficient time to review and act upon Executive Regulation 16-13. Absent such an extension the Personnel Regulations would expire on January 5, 2014, and this would cause a major disruption in the administration of County government. The public interest will be materially harmed if the current sunset date is not extended.

Section 2. Action

The sunset date of the Montgomery County Personnel Regulations is extended from January 5, 2014 to April 5, 2014.

Section 3. Effective Date

The regulation becomes effective January 5, 2014 for a period of ninety days.
