COMCOR 10B.07.02 Establishment of Annual Registration Fee for Common Ownership Communities

10B.07.02.01 Annual Registration Fee

[An] The annual registration fee [of] is \$6.50 per unit [is hereby established].

A unit [shall] <u>must</u> be assessed only one registration fee by the Department, regardless of common ownership communities that govern that unit.

Registration fees [shall] <u>must</u> not be pro-rated and must be payable to Montgomery County, Maryland on an annual basis.

All fees are an annual registration fee and must be paid at the time of application and each subsequent annual renewal.

[10B.07.02.02 Enforcement

Failure to register is a Class A violation under Section 1-19 of the Montgomery County Code and also makes the community ineligible to file a dispute under Chapter 10B of the Code.]
