
DEVELOPMENT NEWS

Construction on Adventist HealthCare's new hospital in White Oak moves toward some major milestones. Floor 6 of 7 is currently underway, with topping out expected in the coming weeks. Rough-in work on the cellar level and placement of exterior wall panels of the main building have begun; with plans for construction on the parking garage and medical office building to begin by the end of this year.

PLANNING BOARD APPROVES THE NEW LATIP FEE FOR WHITE OAK

On September 28th, the Planning Board approved Appendix 4 of the LATR Guidelines which addresses the new LATIP fee for development and transportation related projects in White Oak. In summary, the information provided in this appendix describes a process that calls for a per trip payment by developers at the building permit stage, based on a \$5,010 per peak hour vehicle trip fee. The fee established in the White Oak LATIP is multiplied by the appropriate trip rates by building type specified in the chart provided in the appendix. The resultant cost will be paid to the Department of Finance. MATCHING MINI GRANTS NOW AVAILABLE FOR NEIGHBORHOOD EVENTS


The Neighborhood Events Matching Mini Grant Fund was established by Montgomery County to assist and encourage neighborhood organizations, block clubs, tenant associations, etc. for community capacity building, networking and to stimulate the local economy. The fund is administered by the five Regional Services Centers, and may be used to hold community/neighborhood events and activities. Maximum grant amount is \$1,000 per year per organization/group. Each grant must be matched dollar for dollar with cash or in-kind donations, and the event must take place by June 30, 2018. The application process is easy. There is no deadline for applying, but funding is limited.
