## ELIGIBILITY

- Must be teen parent (pregnant or expecting at 19 or younger) We are open to moms and dads!
- 25 or younger at time of application
- Attending, or planning to attend, a nonprofit 2 or 4 year college in the DC metro region (living within ~50 miles of DC) Planning to take at least 6 credits per semester
- U.S. Citizen, Permanent legal resident, DACA status, or any other visa that allows in-state tuition and work eligibility
