





COMMON CONCERNS FROM EMS

We don't give fluids to trauma patients anymore, unless:



Systolic BP <90mmHg: small boluses (max 250mL) to achieve and maintain an SBP of 90mmHg.

Head injured patients: small boluses (max 250mL) to achieve and maintain an SBP of 110mmHg

This is permissive hypotension.

Administration of LR to hemorrhaging patients outside of these parameters can be harmful. It is not a benign treatment.
