

MCFRS HazMat 5 Minute Drill – Common Household Chemical Combinations

As spring cleaning gets into full swing be on the look out for calls where complainants have respiratory issues, skin irritations and burning or watery eyes.

Many common cleaning products when combined can have hazardous outcomes.

If you see cleaning chemicals or patients state they were cleaning, immediately move the person outside and call for Hazmat where appropriate.

Bleach + Ammonia



= Chloramine

Chloramine smells like chlorine. It irritates eyes, skin, and mucous membranes.

Bleach + Alcohol



= Chloroform

Chloroform can knock you out. It causes liver damage and potentially respiratory or cardiac failure.

Bleach + Vinegar



= Chlorine Gas

Chlorine is a toxic gas that attacks the eyes, respiratory system, and skin.

Peroxide + Vinegar



= Peracetic Acid

Peracetic acid is highly corrosive and irritates the eyes, skin, and respiratory system.

When in doubt, contact ECC and ask for an alternate channel with Hazmat.
