SUBJECT: Portable Radio Use While Engaging in Firefighting Operations

A study conducted by NIST indicated that the firefighter's portable radio offers the best protection during firefighting operations if the radio is carried inside the sewn-on breast pocket of the turnout coat. Positioning the portable radio in this pocket is also the optimal location for transmitting and receiving radio messages.

Recent enhancements of the MCFRS specifications for the Personal Protective Envelope provide the turnout coat's radio pocket with a higher thermal protection rating, to better protect the portable radio. These enhancements were made to ensure the radio is available to personnel when it is most needed.

When firefighter PPE is worn during all firefighting operations, the portable radio must be carried inside the sewn-on breast pocket of the turnout coat.
