SUBJECT: Certified Chief Officer Requirements: Command Competency Knowledge and Laboratory Evaluation

All MCFRS Certified Chief Officers must complete the MCFRS on-line Knowledge component of Command Competency Evaluation by **October 22, 2007**. Completion of the Command Competency Laboratory Practical Exercise Evaluation is required by **March 1, 2008**.

Certified Chief Officers must complete these components of the Command Competencies, as required in Executive Regulation No. 18-05AM, *Certification Standards for Training, Experience and Credentialing Requirements*. Section 4.i. of the Regulation requires Certified Chief Officers to successfully complete an annual Competency Evaluation and Annual Peer Evaluation to maintain eligibility to participate in the Integrated Emergency Command Structure (IECS) at the Certified Chief Officer level. The Peer Evaluations will be conducted after the Knowledge and Laboratory Practical Command Exercise Competency Evaluations have been successfully completed.

LFRD Certified Chief Officers who do not successfully complete the MCFRS on-line Command Competency Knowledge Evaluation and the Laboratory Practical Command Exercise Evaluation within the established time frames will be placed on the IECS List in the Captain's rank until the evaluations have been successfully completed.

Career Certified Chief Officers who do not successfully complete the MCFRS on-line Command Competency Knowledge Evaluation and the Laboratory Practical Command Exercise Evaluation within the established time frames will be removed from the IECS list until the evaluations have been successfully completed.
