SUBJECT: Emergency Vehicle Driver Training Policy

On November 1, 1999, the Fire and Rescue Commission amended Section 5.a. of the Fire and Rescue Commission's Emergency Vehicle Driver Training Policy No. 23-07 to read:

"The driver candidate must present a valid motor vehicle operator's license of the appropriate class for inspection. **Tiller operators are required to have a valid Maryland class B (or the equivalent of a Maryland class B) motor vehicle operators license. ...**"

DFRS personnel are to adhere to this policy. There is no change to the requirement to maintain a Maryland class A or equivalent from another state to drive a tractor-trailer. If you should have any questions regarding this issue, please contact your District Chief.
