Title:	Low-Titer O-Positive Whole Blood Administration Number: 2024 – 05

Issued by:	Roger M. Stone MD, MS – MCFRS Medical Director
Purpose:	To issue program guidelines for the management and administration of low-titer Opositive whole blood (LTO+WB).
Target Patient Population:	Patients who meet Maryland Medical Protocol criteria for the administration of LTO+WB.
Guideline:	Only personnel credentialed in LOW-TITER O+ WHOLE BLOOD (LTO+WB) administration may administer whole blood to a patient. Once administration has begun, the credentialed provider must remain with the patient until turnover of care at the destination hospital or to another credentialed EMS clinician (e.g. MSP paramedic).
	MCFRS EMS Clinicians will follow the current LTO+WB TRANSFUSION protocol contained in the Maryland Medical Protocols for Emergency Medical Services. This Clinical Practice Guideline is intended to specify certain procedures and methods not defined in the protocol.
