<b>Purpose:</b>	To specify requirements for using the AutoVent3000		
<b>Target Patient Population:</b>	All ALS clinicians		
<b>Guideline:</b>	<p>The management of chronically ventilated patients is a low-frequency, high-impact event. These cases increase the demands of and the risk to MCFRS and its responding clinicians.</p> <p>When applying the AutoVent3000 a minimum of two ALS clinicians must be present at the patient's side. At least one ALS clinician must have completed the <b>PSTA-Approved AutoVent3000 training program</b>. A trained clinician must be present during transport when the AutoVent3000 is deployed.</p> <p>Questions may be directed to any assigned EMS Duty Officer.</p>
