SUBJECT: Incident Response Policy Training

With the publication of the Incident Response Policy on April 14, 2017, there will be a training program offered to include 1) on-line videos and assessment located at www.mcfrsit.com/trackingincident/, and 2) instructor-led Command Officer Professional Development and Improvement classes to be scheduled by the Public Safety Training Academy staff.

All Certified Chief Officers *must* complete both parts of the training program by **June 30, 2017**, prior to the implementation of the Incident Response Policy. Certified Chief Officers who fail to comply with the training program requirements will result in the removal of Certified Chief Officer status from the Integrated Emergency Command Structure, with subsequent disciplinary action and/or reduction in rank, as appropriate.
