

SAFETY OFFICER BED BUG CHECKLIST:

- Meet unit at the station after they clear the hospital.
- Crew decon:
 - Undress outside (as privacy allows)
 - Clean contaminated clothes (dryer/washer/dryer)
- Crew showers
- Remove Tango meter before spraying
- Using Sterifab, spray unit front & back; thoroughly spray cot, seats, and bags
- Shut unit doors for 30 minutes
- Crew must “Heavy Decon” after 30-minutes & return unit to service
- If crew finds visible bed bugs during decon:
 - Park unit outside
 - Switch to reserve unit
 - Station Officer call 240-777-7777 & submits defect through facilities defect reporting system (using the affected station number). Be sure to include unit #, stock #, and specific location of where the unit was parked.
 - 2 hours after professional treatment, the unit can return to service.

FACILITIES SECTION:

- Confirm report is entered into the MCFRS Fire Station Defect Reporting System assigned to DGS/DFM.
