<p>** Hospitals in the County are open, but should be reserved for urgent situations. Each hospital has its own financial assistance program with its own application process for uninsured/underinsured patients. Patients should contact the Financial Assistance office of the hospital and try to apply prior to receiving care, if possible, but can also apply after receiving care.</p> <p>** Urgent Care clinics are open, but you should inform them of whether or not you have any health insurance coverage and confirm the cost of the visit and any additional services prior to receiving care, if possible. Different clinics accept different types of insurance. Going to a clinic that accepts your insurance will result in a lower bill, and going to a clinic that does not accept your insurance (or when you are uninsured), will result in a higher bill.</p> <p>** The clinics listed below are generally used by patients who do not have private insurance. Some are private clinics that accept uninsured patients, but those without health coverage will pay a higher cost. If you do not have insurance, you can apply for coverage through the Maryland Health Connection through June 15, 2020 (see below). Those who do not qualify for insurance through the Maryland Health Connection (eg, undocumented individuals) may apply for County programs if they are low-income. See below for more info.</p> <p>** COVID-19 Testing: Call your healthcare provider or one of the clinics below (if you do not have a regular healthcare provider) to get screened. Note: Not all cases will result in a recommendation for testing, and those with milder symptoms will likely be instructed to perform self-care at home. If testing is warranted, the provider may submit an online order for testing at the White Oak VEIP testing site. You must then make an appointment at the White Oak testing site, and provide your appointment confirmation when you arrive for testing. Note that, while some Urgent Care clinics are conducting testing, you will likely have to pay a fee for the visit.
