



## What is the Working Parents Assistance (WPA) Program?

Montgomery County's Working Parents Assistance (WPA) Program is a County sponsored program that is committed to helping eligible county residents to pay for child care. While parents are at work or school, they can feel confident that their children are in a safe and caring environment.

### You may qualify for the Working Parents Assistance Program if you:



Are a Montgomery County resident.



Are a parent or guardian of an infants of 6 weeks to 13 years of age, or up to 19 years old if the child has a disability and needs care.



Must be employed 25 hours or more per week or enrolled in a full time undergraduate/vocational program or combination of both.

#### Note:

- Immigration status is not a requirement for parents or children to participate in the WPA program.
- Your selected child care provider must be licensed by the State of Maryland.
