Maternal Health Update Dr. Kisha Davis	 Dr. Kisha Davis shared the following Maternal Health Update: Advancing Maternal Health Summit was held on March 14, 2025. The gathering united healthcare leaders, policymakers, community advocates, and families to foster partnerships, examine systemic 		

	 issues, and develop actionable strategies to improve maternal health equity. Hospitals and other partners are doing wonderful work to address postpartum issues such as hemorrhage. Stressed importance of wraparound care. Planning to form a formal taskforce to address this health concern. A two-page summary highlighting discussions and next steps from the event will be released, in addition to a longer report. Once this is released, a call for volunteers to serve on the taskforce will be shared. 		
CHIP Update & Timeline Elizabeth Beck	 Elizabeth Beck presented an overview of updates in the CHIP process, including an updated timeline for Health Priority Action Teams, the final list of participants, and a refresher on Healthy Montgomery Steering Committee Members role in the process. - Members suggested additional populations and areas for which Term Member organizations might be considered, including the aging and the disabled populations, and the housing sector.
