November is Remembrance and Reconciliation Month

The County Commission on Remembrance and Reconciliation will hold special events and activities throughout the month of November, and encourages other groups to hold its own events, to promote a better understanding of County history - including recognition of three men who were the known victims of racial terror lynchings in the late 1800s.

Throughout the month, MCPS students will learn about landmarks tied to African American history. Similarly, the Commission invites residents, agencies and the private sector to engage in conversations and practices amongst families, neighbors and coworkers to acknowledge, alleviate and dispel the harms caused by racism and discrimination as evidenced in words, acts, and deeds.
