  - ii. June 11 2025 last board meeting. Director gave short report.
    - Kappa Alpha Psi donated program on fraternity's history. A new library app? Construction refresh for some branches is underway. Book Mobile is in trial phase - unclear on full plan, but an EV car with funds from state, county, and American Rescue Plan.
    - Chair's Report: One Board Member resigned. If anyone is interested, a new position should open up. Tim Lighter is no longer Chair, but still a member. New Chair elected.

a. Robert: What is the population that Praisner serves? How many people? Adults?

- i. Praisner is one of the least dense locations. Burtonsville is 20-30,000. PG and Howard County residents sometimes utilize Praisner. Very diverse part of the county. French, Spanish speaking (why we have French and Spanish story time). Previously had more Korean population but has changed since 10-15 years. White Oak is sister branch.
- ii. Who do we serve? Families. Until last month, no bus service on weekends. Awaiting to see how this changes circulation.
- iii. In terms of circulation, not one of MCPL's highest. Focus on programs. Especially teens (and during the school year, not the summer). This is likely due to the MS and HS are down the street.
- iv. Are people living in the area that are unaware of the library?
- v. Robert: community outreach efforts. CVS community involvement to coordinate potentially.
